WARRANTY ON WOOD DOORS

Cabinet Doors & More warrants that its cabinet doors and drawer fronts will be free from defect in workmanship and material for one year from the date of shipment. The natural beauty of wood does allow for limited amounts of natural characteristics of wood to show. Color variance from piece to piece is not covered under warranty.

Cabinet Doors & More will not be liable for any damages caused by improper handling, storage or installation of our products. Cabinet Doors & More will not be liable for any costs incurred by the customer for finishing, removal, installation, travel, or labor of any kind, nor any other product used with our components. This warranty covers only the replacement of our product as ordered by the customer.

Due to the natural expansion and contraction of wood, any product with a laminated panel over 24" wide will carry no warranty. This includes but is not limited to raised panel doors and drawer fronts.

Any change in humidity or heat in a house may cause doors to warp or twist. It is suggested that the end user control the humidity in their home by means of a humidifier, to stay at a consistent 30% humidity. Wood doors should not be installed in buildings that have little or no heat. Wood doors should not be installed prior to basements being poured. All these will cause doors to warp and will not be covered under warranty. Panel shrinkage is not covered under warranty as wood will shrink and expand with the change in humidity.

Any doors over 44" tall or 24" wide, must be manufacture with a center rail to try to help avoid warpage.

Cabinet Doors and More offers an acceptable tolerance in sizing of \pm 1-1mm. Warping is also a factor in warped doors. Cabinet Doors and More Warrants any door or drawer front under 24" x 44" will have an allowance of 1/8 for warpage. Double panel doors up to 24" x 72" have a tolerance of \pm 4" for warpage. Any doors over 24" wide or over 72" tall will not have a warranty for warpage.

WARRANTY ON FINISHING

Cabinet Doors & More warrants the finishing that we apply to the doors to be free from defect in workmanship for one year from date of shipment. This warranty will only cover the lacquers that we suggest should be used on the doors. Lacquers supplied or

requested by customer will not be covered under this warranty by any means. We have done extensive research on the products that we use, in order to try to avoid any defects at later dates.

This warranty does not cover changing of color, as all woods will age and change colors to a certain degree. The clear lacquer that we use as our standard is rated very low in discoloration, has UV blockers, and has been freeze tested, but will not stop the wood from aging.

This warranty will not cover any problems with shrinking panel or stain shadow lines. All wood doors should be in a controlled environment in which humidity can be controlled.

There will be no warranty on any wood doors that are to be painted a solid color. With the natural expansion and contraction of wood, the paint will crack. Any moisture under the paint or lacquer will cause it to peel.

On doors supplied by customers, there will be no warranty on the finish peeling. If moisture content is too high in these doors it could cause the lacquer to peel.

Cabinet Doors & More will not be liable for any damages caused by improper handling, storage or installation of our products. Cabinet Doors & More and/or Elias Woodwork will not be liable for any costs incurred by the customer for finishing, removal, installation, travel, or labor of any kind, nor any other product used with our components. This warranty will cover only the replacement of our product as ordered by the customer and the shipping charges to and from Cabinet Doors & More.

WARRANTY ON THERMOFOIL DOORS

Cabinet Doors & More warranties any thermofoil doors manufactured in our plant against yellowing, delaminating, or manufacturing defects for a period of 5 years from invoice date. Warranty covers the replacement of parts, but does not cover the labor involved in the replacement of these parts.

Exclusions to the warranty include:

- exposure to temperatures over 85C (185F)
- abuse of the doors
- improper cleaning of doors
- Heat exposure to doors is the most common damage issue with thermoplastic doors; it is very easy to determine cause of damage as the foil will shrink when exposed to heat. This is not classified as delaminating and is not covered under warranty.

WARRANTY ON SLAB EDGEBANDED DOORS

Cabinet Doors & More warranties any edge banded doors, supplied by Cabinet Doors and More, Manufactured in our shop or distributed, for a total of 5 years against manufacturing defects.

All Melamine, High Gloss Acrylic, Super Matt Polymer edge banded doors are warranted for 5 years against warpage of more than 1/8"

Any panels over 42" tall are not warranty for warpage.

Warranty does not cover abuse, inappropriate use, door alteration or negligence

Sizes are guaranteed to +/- 1/32" tolerances

All Claims are FOB our Edmonton Location. Warranty will not cover any on site labor to replace parts, or freight to get parts to site.

Products with protective films, the film must be removed after cabinet installation is completed.
